Regime Change is on its Way to Iran

Washington, DC. - On behalf of the **HAKHA Movement for Freedom and democracy in Iran**, Dr. Ahura-Pirouz Khaleghi Yazdi will hold a press conference at 2:00 PM EDT on Thursday, June 2, 2005 at the National Press Club (529 14th Street, N.W. Washington D.C. 20045) to discuss change of regime in Iran.

The HAKHA Movement is a freedom coalition of pro-democracy Iranians. It champions the vision of a free Iran reclaiming its rightful position in the international community. The HAKHA Movement is a global initiative to advance, in common cause on behalf of all Iranians, the purposes of national self-determination, the principles of secular democracy, the capacity for responsible self-government, the respect for individual and universal human rights, and the provision of institutions of ordered liberty essential for a free Iran.
